In 2025, International Project celebrated 30 years of ministry. For three decades, God has faithfully sustained our work through prayer, open doors, and generous partners like you. From the beginning, we have felt called to reach those with little or no access to the Gospel, and we have pursued that calling by engaging diaspora communities, Unreached People Groups living outside their homelands. That commitment continues to guide how we live, serve, and share the Gospel today.

This year also marked the launch of our refined Decade Forward vision, a ten year commitment to raise up new laborers and see churches planted through diaspora Unreached People Groups (UPGs). We are not looking back to conclude a story, but looking forward as 30 years of faithfulness becomes a launchpad for the decade ahead.



Spiritual Engagements in Our 30th Year

In our 30th year of ministry, International Project teams initiated over 5,708 spiritual engagements, mostly with unreached people. These Gospel centered conversations took place with thousands of Muslims, Hindus, Buddhist, Jewish, and people from other faith backgrounds.

Generational Gospel Movement

In 2025, we saw exciting Gospel movement through former Muslims who are now reaching their own people for Christ. Through their faithfulness and obedience to the Great Commission, they have led many to faith, baptized new believers, and seen several new churches started among historically hard to reach people groups. 
Stories from the Field: God at Work Through Arabs in NYC

Astoria: Gospel conversations and professions of faith

In Astoria, one of New York City's most globally diverse neighborhoods, International Project workers labored to engaged the over 100,000 Arabs living there. In 2025, this team initiated **694 personal spiritual engagements**. Through these ongoing relationships, **11 individuals professed faith** in Christ and **2 were baptized**. Continue to pray for the work the Lord is doing among Arabs in NYC.

These moments show what happens when the Gospel is lived out faithfully over time, creating space for the Holy Spirit to work, among people groups who have never heard the message of Jesus.





Stories from the Field: God at Work among the Diaspora in Rome

Rome: A Cultural Insider Multiplying the Gospel

Ahmed, a refugee from Bangladesh, connected with International Project through the Agape Center in downtown Rome. In 2025, our Rome team and Ahmed **personally engaged 424 individuals spiritually**. Discipled to become a Gospel multiplier, Ahmed now reaches the Bengali diaspora living in Rome. Through his obedience and the grace of God, many have followed Jesus, been baptized, and contributed to church planting in Italy and Bangladesh. God is at work through diaspora communities living in Rome.

Stories from the Field:

Faith That Couldn't Be Detained



Binta fled her home country after being abandoned by the father of her child. She arrived at our refugee program in Central Asia with no food, shelter, or support. Our team quickly connected her with a safehouse affiliated with our ministry. Though she was instructed to come alone, she brought her friend Esther, a decision that would prove providential.

Esther had also fled the same country, escaping a Muslim religious cult that was pressuring her to become a ritual “goddess,” a role connected to her grandmother’s leadership in the cult. Like Binta, she was a young mother left to survive on her own.

While staying at the safehouse, the two women joined a Bible study with other refugee women. On the very first night, both expressed a deep hunger to know God. Binta shared that it was the first time anyone had ever prayed for her. As they studied Scripture, both women placed their faith in Jesus and were baptized in a makeshift bathtub.

Soon after her baptism, Esther was detained by police and placed in a detention center. Yet even there, the Gospel spread. Esther began sharing her faith with other women, and a Bible study formed inside the center.

After her release, Esther started a Discovery Bible Study among West African refugees. Today, six women meet regularly, and more are asking to be baptized. Our team continues to disciple and train both Binta and Esther, praying that God will multiply the Gospel through their lives.

Growth in Participation

As the harvest continues to grow, International Project has seen a significant increase in participation. Across all programs, engagement rose by more than 90% in 2025, reflecting a growing openness among believers to take meaningful steps toward cross-cultural Gospel engagement.

Our Global Ministry Footprint

In 2025, International Project ministry teams served across four major strategic locations, carefully selected for their access to the nations and their opportunity for sustained Gospel engagement.

How do we track our data?

ShareApp: A centralized tool that allows our teams to track spiritual conversations, prayer needs, and ministry fruit, helping leaders steward resources, manage follow up with those we engage, and pray for God’s continued work among the nations.



Each pin marks a country of origin for someone we engaged with the Gospel in 2025. These 79+ countries represent 130+ people groups and show how God is bringing the nations to our doorstep, many from the 10/40 Window.

Strengthening the Foundation

Platforms That Support the Work

Over 30 years of ministry, International Project has continually adapted its methods while remaining anchored to timeless Gospel principles. In 2025, several key ministry platforms continued to strengthen our ability to support workers and multiply impact.




- **Equip Training Program:** A ten month immersive, cross cultural training program located in New York City which prepares participants for disciple making and church planting through diaspora Unreached People Groups. Equip combines hands-on ministry with expert led training and has been trusted by 10+ mission agencies to train their workers.
- **Community Centers:** Located in New York City, Rome, and Central Asia, these centers meet practical needs through ESL classes, art programs, food distribution, and a safe house for women and children. These platforms foster trust and create natural pathways for Gospel conversations and Discovery Bible Studies.
- **Digital Platforms:** Custom designed tools that connect international students to community and spiritual engagement opportunities and match refugees with practical resources. These platforms allow workers to meet felt needs while intentionally sharing the hope found in Christ.

Together, these platforms help ensure that as the harvest grows, workers are equipped, supported, and able to focus on faithful Gospel presence.



Thirty years ago, International Project began with a vision to see churches started through the unreached living outside their homelands. Today, there are more opportunities than ever to be part of that work. As we look ahead, we need the people, resources, and support to respond faithfully.

In our 30th year, International Project launched **Decade Forward**, a ten-year vision rooted in God's past faithfulness and focused on multiplication in the years to come.

Our Focus for the Decade Ahead

- Launch 100: Mobilizing 100 long term workers by 2030
- Expanding teams into new strategic European locations
- Strengthening church partnerships nationwide
- Continuing to invest in worker care, prayer, and leadership development
- Planting more fourth-generation churches
- Training and deploying 50 cultural insiders to initiate Gospel movements within their own communities
