Scriptures on Evangelism

Matthew 28:18-20 “And Jesus came and said to them, ‘All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age.’” (NIV)

Ephesians 6:19-20 “Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel.”

Colossians 4:3-4 “Pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message...Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should.”

Acts 4:29 “Now, Lord... enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness.”

Isaiah 6:8 “Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, ‘Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?’ And I said, ‘Here am I. Send me!’”

2 Timothy 4:2 “Preach the word, be urgent in season and out of season, convince, rebuke, and exhort, be unfailing in patience and in teaching.”

Psalms 96:2-3 “Sing to the Lord, bless his name; tell of his salvation from day to day. Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples!”

Matthew 5:13-16 “You are the salt of the earth; but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trodden under foot by men. ‘You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Nor do men light a lamp and put it under a bushel, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.’”

Matthew 9:37-38 “Then he said to his disciples, ‘The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.’”

Luke 19:10 “For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”

Acts 1:8 “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

1 Corinthians 15:1, 3-4 “Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand... For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures.”

Romans 1:16 “For I am not ashamed of the gospel: it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who has faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.”

John 14:6 “Jesus answered, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’”

1 Peter 3:15 “But in your hearts reverence Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to make a defense to any one who calls you to account for the hope that is in you, yet do it with gentleness and reverence.”

John 3:16 “For God so loved [Name], that he gave his one and only Son, that if [Name] believes in him, [he/she] shall not perish but have eternal life.”

Romans 10:9-10 “If [Name] declares with [his/her] mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believes in [his/her] heart that God raised him from the dead, [Name] will be saved.”

1 Timothy 2:3-4 “God our Savior... wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth — including [Name].”

2 Peter 3:9 “The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise... he is patient with [Name], not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.”

Romans 5:8 “But God demonstrates his own love for [Name] in this: While [Name] was still a sinner, Christ died for [him/her].”

2 Corinthians 5:20 “So we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We beseech you on behalf of Christ, [Name] be reconciled to God.”

Matthew 4:17 “From that time on Jesus began to preach, ‘Repent, [Name] for the kingdom of heaven has come near.’”

Psalms 43:3 “Send [Name] your light and your faithful care, let them lead [him/her].”

John 8:32 “Then [Name] will know the truth, and the truth will set [him/her] free.”

Acts 3:19 “Lord, help [Name] repent and turn to you, so that [his/her] sins may be wiped out, and times of refreshing may come.”

1 John 1:9 “If [Name] confesses [his/her] sins, [you] are faithful and just and will forgive [his/her] sins and purify [him/her] from all unrighteousness.”

Romans 6:22-23 “But now that [name] have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Acts 16:14 “The Lord opened [Name]’s heart to respond to Paul’s message.”

Ezekiel 36:26 “I will give [Name] a new heart and put a new spirit in [him/her]; I will remove from [Name] [his/her] heart of stone and give [him/her] a heart of flesh.”

2 Corinthians 4:4 “The god of this age has blinded the minds of [Name]... Lord, remove the veil so [Name] can see the light of the gospel.”

Mark 16:15-16 “[Jesus] said to them, ‘Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved.’”

Colossians 1:9-10 “[I pray] that [Name] may be filled with the knowledge of [God’s] will... that [he/she] may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way.”

Philippians 1:6 “[I am] confident of this, that he who began a good work in [Name] will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.”

Ephesians 3:17-19 “I pray that Christ may dwell in [Name]’s heart through faith... that [he/she] may grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.”
