

We're looking forward to seeing you at Timothy Ambition!

Participants in Timothy Ambition (TA) are required to agree to the following expectations. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact us before agreeing to the expectations. Team leaders are responsible for agreeing to the expectations on behalf of their team, and ensuring that all team members agree to and comply with the expectations.

Age:

- Participants in TA must be in high school or entering high school in the Fall. **If you are interested in bringing a group that includes any participants younger than this, please contact us. Exceptions may be made to this rule, on a case-by-case basis.*

Fee:

- The non-refundable TA Fee will be paid two months before arriving in NYC. This fee should be paid with one check, made out to International Project.
- All teams must have a point person/team leader. The team leader will be responsible for coordinating transportation to NYC (booking flights, buying bus tickets, etc.), arranging hotel/hostel stays, facilitating pre-trip training modules, and collecting the TA Fee.

Training:

- Teams will receive a pre-field ministry training module. The team leader will organize/facilitate this training. Teams are encouraged to complete the training at least two weeks prior to departure.
- Our TA Coordinator will call or video chat team leaders several weeks before their team's arrival in NYC, to check in with the team (regarding training modules, questions, etc.).

During the Trip:

Timothy Ambition Expectations

- *Every person* participating in TA will be expected to initiate spiritual conversations with people in public spaces.
- All participants will commit to be active ministers of the gospel while they're here.
- Evangelism ("Seed Sowing") will be done in small groups of 2-3 people, usually in pairs. This means that teams will be divided into smaller groups for a large portion of the day and may not see their "entire group" until the evening. Each group of 2-3 will always be within eyesight of a chaperone.
- International Project missionaries will not accompany teams as they engage in daily street evangelism and outreach but will escort teams to the neighborhood where they will be working.
- When Timothy Ambition participants meet a spiritually interested contact during "Seed Sowing" times, they will follow instructions given by TA coordinator on how to connect that individual with us for follow-up. The coordinator may also encourage the TA participant to follow up with the contact again during the week.
- Participants will dress very modestly during their outreach, keeping in mind cultural appropriateness among people groups you may be interacting with. See further explanation for expectations on modest clothing in the "Timothy Ambition FAQ" document.
- Participants will eat at least one meal out per day in the diaspora neighborhoods where they are ministering for "Seed Sowing."
- Teams will organize their own activities for their free day.
- All groups and group members will attend daily trainings and "Seed Sowing" times.

Timothy Ambition Expectations

- If a team is running late or is unable to make it to a training/ministry location on time, then the team leader should contact the TA coordinator as soon as possible.
- Chaperones are responsible to either hold the MetroCards of their students, or to ensure that all students have their cards with them.
- *Participants should understand that this trip will be a challenging and tiring ministry week; however, we believe that God will do great things in and through you while you are here!*
