#### THE FOURTH SOIL IN ACTION

Debesh began following Jesus in 2019 after Mahin, a fellow Bangladeshi, shared the Good News with him at the Agape Center in Rome. A year later, Debesh was visiting family in Bangladesh when the pandemic struck. Suddenly Debesh could not return to Italy.

Rather than fret over this change in plans, Debesh saw a God-given opportunity to share Jesus in his homeland. Empowered by the Holy Spirit and building on his rudimentary knowledge of Discovery Bible Study, he gathered several families together. He showed them how to read a series of Bible passages and ask God to help them understand and obey. **Can you guess what happened next?** 

One by one, nearly all the families in Debesh's study group decided to follow Jesus! Debesh helped them form a simple church like the one he belongs to in Italy. Then he started a second study with another group of families. Most of them came to know Jesus, too, and became another brand new church. When Debesh returned to Italy, he promptly started a third group there. This third group is still studying together, growing in understanding as they practice obeying what God reveals to them through Scripture.

Who would have thought? Two churches planted and a third group diligently studying the Bible within two years. Within one of the largest unreached people groups in the world, and in a country where traditional missionaries are not welcome. . . This is the Fourth Soil in action.

## MULTIPLYING 30, 60, AND 100 TIMES

As you know from gardening or farming, most of the work happens long before the harvest is gathered: Tilling the soil, planting the seeds at the right time and spacing, watering them regularly, applying fertilizer, and carefully removing weeds, all while praying for good weather. A spiritual harvest takes preparation and hard work, too.

For Debesh, it started with Italian lessons. For Ali. a student from Saudi Arabia who recently told his parents he no longer believes in Islam, English lessons progressed to Bible study. For Seynabou, who is now making disciples in her home of Senegal, she overheard a missionary sharing Christ at a corner store and asked how to do that among her people. For Elira, a new believer from Albania, compassionate food distribution opened her heart.

And before those seeds could be planted, each mission worker, whether serving for a week or a lifetime, had to be trained. At International Project, training means practice. Going out two by two to have spiritual conversations. Learning to lead a Discovery Bible Study. Practicing language about Jesus that resonates with a Muslim or a Hindu. Getting feedback. receivina mentoring encouragement, and most importantly, persevering even when it's hard.
